The writ petition is filed by the borrower Gurjit Kaur seeking a direction to the respondents to allow the petitioner to have access to her premises and take possession of her personal belongings that are kept in the premises taken possession of by 2nd respondent in terms of Section 13(4) of the Securitisation & Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents very fairly submitted before us that the respondents have no objection to the writ petitioner to entering into the premises to take possession of her personal belongings that are kept in the premises.

In view of the above submissions made by learned counsel appearing for the respondents, the petitioner is permitted to have access to her premises i.e. Flat No.B-303, Tower B (3rd Floor), Wellington Heights TDI City, Sector 117, District Mohali on 04.07.2016 at 10.00 a.m. and take possession of her personal belongings in the presence of the Kanungo and police authorities who shall assist the petitioner to take possession of her personal belongings.

With the above directions, the writ petition is disposed of.
