Petitioner was engaged as Anganwadi worker on 22.12.2009 in Ward No.4, Village Bareta, District Mansa. It is claimed that she was appointed being a widow.

The petitioner is seeking a writ of Mandamus to the official respondents for permitting her to rejoin as Anganwadi worker after permitting her to withdraw her resignation letter dated 24.7.2015 (P-2).

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the resignation letter was got submitted on account of the FIR No.65 dated 18.08.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station City 2, Mansa (P-1) wherein the allegations were that the petitioner had produced a fake matriculation certificate. It is submitted that upon subsequent enquiry it has been found

that the matriculation certificate submitted by the petitioner is genuine.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner and perusing the paper book no case for issuance of direction is made out.

Perusal of the resignation letter clearly states that the resignation was submitted on account of personal difficulty. The resignation was accepted in October 2015 and now, after lapse of many months the basis for seeking withdrawal is a complete afterthought.

In view of the above, present petition is hereby dismissed.
