Learned counsel for the respondents, at the very outset, submit that since appeals of the petitioners have been decided by the competent authority, present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of, as such.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let the instant writ petition be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous, enabling the petitioners to challenge the order passed by the appellate authority independently, before the appropriate forum, in accordance with law, however, stay order, granted by this Court vide order dated 11.7.2016, may be ordered to continue for a period of three weeks from today so that the rights of the petitioners may not be rendered infructuous.

In view of the above-said respective stands taken by the learned counsel for the contesting parties, instant writ petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous, however, stay order granted by this Court vide order dated 11.7.2016 shall continue to operate in favour of the petitioners for another period of three weeks to enable them to avail their remedy against the appellate order.

Disposed of, accordingly.
