After hearing for some time, it was noticed that the petitioners have questioned the show cause notice of termination. Perusal of the records reveals that the order of renewal dated 23.05.2013, there is a deeming clause which reads as under:-

*“ 7. If the contract is not renewed at the end of the term, the contract shall come to an end on the expiry of the period mentioned in Point 1 above.”*

Read with earlier decision passed in CWP No. 20117 of 2015 filed by the All India LIC SMEs Group/Association (Regd.) versus Life Insurance Corporation of India and others wherein the petitioners were member of the Group or Association-petitioner. In the said CWP before

their termination they had approached this Court seeking for certain directions like restraining the respondents to not to terminate their services. By deeming clause imposed in the renewal of appointment order, the petitioners are stated to have been relieved on 20.04.2016, 23.04.2016, 25.04.2016 and 19.04.2016. These relieving orders are subsequent to show cause notice which are impugned in the present petition. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that order of termination has not been served therefore, it is presumed that there is no existence of termination orders. Even assuming that if there is no termination order by virtue of clause imposed in the renewal of appointment order there is a deeming clause that their services shall come to an end.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the petition. He is permitted to withdraw the same.

CWP stands dismissed as withdrawn.
