This petition is filed for seeking a direction to the respondents to register the name of the petitioner in the register of pharmacists as he had obtained a degree of Bachelor of Pharmacy(B.Pharm) from Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra. The only hitch, in the registration of the name of the petitioner earlier was that he had passed 10+2 examination (Senior Secondary Examination) from National Institute of Open School, New Delhi, prior to 13.06.2007.

Shri Amrit Paul, Advocate appearing, on behalf of respondent No. 3, has produced an order of Division Bench passed by this Court in LPA No. 800 of 2015, titled as Khayati Moudgil vs. Union of India and others, decided on 19.10.2015 in which the students/candidates, like the

petitioner, who had passed their 10+2 from National Institute of Open School, New Delhi, has been allowed registration as Pharmacist under the relevant provisions of the Pharmacy Act, 1948.

Since there is no contest to this petition, therefore, the interim order dated 23.07.2014 to register the name of the petitioner as pharmacist is made absolute and the petition is disposed of.
