The petitioner had been detained to appear in the examination of Diploma in Elementary Education of the Ist year on account of the fact that she had shortage of lectures due to facing of medical problems as she was expecting a child.

In reply filed on behalf of respondents, it has been mentioned that examination started on 13.6.2016 and the last exam was held on 13.7.2016 and the petitioner has already taken admission in the Ist year of the said diploma and deposited the fees for the said course.

No interim order was passed in favour of the petitioner while issuing notice of motion. Replication has not been filed to controvert the same. Even otherwise, this Court has considered the issue whether relaxation can be given or not in such circumstances in **Civil Writ Petition No.9696 of 2016-Jyoti Vs. Registrar, Punjab University, Chandigarh and others** decided on 23.8.2016.

In view of the reasons recorded in the said judgment, the present writ petition is dismissed.
