S. Gurnam Singh son of Late Shri Udham Singh-respondent No.4, who is father of applicant-petitioner, is also present in the Court along with his wife.

Ms.Avleen Kohli, Advocate, learned counsel for the respondent No.4 also verifies the factum of compromise, arrived at between the parties.

It was also inquired by the Court from S. Gurnam Singh and he was kind enough to say that this application moved by his son-petitioner may be accepted.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and going through the record of the case, order dated 12.07.2016 passed by this Court, whereby writ petition was dismissed, is hereby recalled, invoking the inherent jurisdiction of this Court, keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case and also with a view to give another chance to the applicant-petitioner to serve his parents properly, in the eve of their life.
