Instant writ petition is directed against two notifications of even date i.e. 12.01.2015 (Annexures P-8 and P-9), whereby some seats were reserved for ladies (including scheduled castes ladies), backward class and general (male and female), in the municipality.

Notice of motion was issued and in compliance thereof, written statement was filed on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2. Thereafter, the writ petition was admitted for regular hearing. That is how, this Court is seized of the matter.

Learned counsel for the State placed before this Court copy of notification dated 10.02.2015 issued by State Election Commission, Punjab, whereby election programme was circulated. Elections to different Municipal Corporations and Committees throughout the State of Punjab were conducted on 25.02.2015. Result of general elections of Municipal Councils/Nagar Panchayats in the State of Punjab was notified. He submits that in this view of

the matter, nothing is left to be decided in the present writ petition and the same may be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

In view of the abovesaid uncontroverted fact situation, present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of, as such.
