This is a petition filed by petitioner challenging the impugned order dated 22.6.2016 (Annexure P6) passed by respondent No.2.

Heard the submission made by the learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner.

On a careful perusal of Annexure P6, it is found that the writ petitioner has been transferred on administrative reasons. On the same day of issuance of the order of transfer, respondent No.2 has also issued a show cause notice to the writ petitioner on a complaint received against him directing him to explain within 15 days.

I find that transfer has been effected as some enquiry has been initiated against the writ petitioner on the basis of a complaint. Under the above circumstances, question of interference in the transfer order passed by the authorities does not merit consideration.

Writ petition is dismissed.
