1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?

**KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)**

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he applied for allotment of retail outlet from Indian Oil Corporation in April 2004. He had purchased the land and obtained necessary N.O.C. Later on, he was informed in November 2007 that the scheme has been changed and he will be allotted retail outlet after some time. Thereafter, again in the new scheme, he applied for and submitted necessary documents in February 2012. However, the petitioner has not received any response from the respondents-Indian Oil Corporation. Therefore, he served a legal notice on 15.11.2015 (Annexure P-8) but it has not been replied so far.

The limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner is that the respondents may be directed to submit the reply of the legal notice.

In these circumstances, the present writ petition is dispose of with liberty to the petitioner to apply under R.T.I. to seek the status of his application and action thereon and thereafter seek appropriate remedy before this Court.
