The petitioner is in the cadre of Assistant Development Officer (Khadi). While he was working in OCKVI, Chandigarh, he has been transferred to Central Office OCKVI (Mumbai) vide order dated 27.03.2015.

2. On 07.08.2013, the petitioner was transferred to Mumbai from Chandigarh. The same has not been given effect due to the administrative reason. Thereafter, on 27.03.2015 (Annexure P9) it was given effect.

3. Feeling aggrieved by communication dated 27.03.2015 (Anexure P-9) the present petition has been filed. On 31.07.2015, it was ordered that "order of status quo with regard to the posting of the petitioner shall be maintained till the next date of hearing". Thereafter, interim order

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was continued from time to time.

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4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the order dated 27.03.2015 (Annexure P-9) may be given effect from 7th of July, 2016.

5. In view of the submission made by the petitioner's counsel, the respondents are directed to give effect to the order dated 27.03.2015 on 07.07.2016.

6. With the above observation, Civil Writ Petition stands disposed of.
