This order shall dispose of CWP Nos.12931 of 2016 titled as
Ashu Sapra Vs. Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak and others, CWP
No.12934 of 2016 titled as Ashwani Kumar and others Vs. Maharshi

Dayanand University, Rohtak and others and CWP No.12959 of 2016 titled as Purusharth Vs. Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak and others.

In these writ petitions notice of motion had been issued, returnable for 16.11.2016.

Oral request for preponement of the date has been made by counsel appearing for the petitioner(s). Mr. Anurag Goyal, learned counsel who is present in Court and represents the Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak does not oppose the prayer.

With the consent of the counsel for the parties, the date in these three writ petitions is preponed from 16.11.2016 and taken up on Board today itself.

The petitioners who had been engaged as Resource Persons purely on contractual basis in different departments under the M.D.U., Rohtak had filed the instant petitions assailing the methodology adopted by the University whereby one set of contractual employee was sought to be replaced by another similar arrangement.

Mr. Anurag Goyal, learned counsel appearing for the respondents has during the course of hearing today brought to the notice of the Court the decision taken by the University in the minutes of a meeting held on 04.08.2016 under the Chairmanship of the Vice Chancellor and as per which directions have been issued to all the Heads of the Departments/Directors to re-engage the Resource Persons already working for the session 2015-16 and without taking their interview and subject to the fulfillment of the prescribed qualifications for the concerned post and also subject to the condition that their work and conduct is certified to be satisfactory by the Head of the concerned Department during the session

In the light of such categoric stand taken on behalf of the University, nothing survives in these three writ petitions and the same are disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
