TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

It is the claim made by counsel that the petitioner was engaged as a Daily Wager with the Forest Department in the year 1995 and she has worked continuously thereafter. Claim set up in the instant petition is for grant of benefit of regularization in service in the light of various policies framed by the State Government from time to time on this subject.

Pleadings on record are completely bereft for this Court to draw any inference as regards the service of the petitioner being continuous in the respondent/Department.

Without making any observations on merits, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the claim of the petitioner strictly in accordance with law in the light of representation dated 12.06.2016 at Annexure P-7 and to pass a detailed speaking order thereupon within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

It is clarified that directions are being issued for deciding the representation of the petitioner as the entire service record of the petitioner against the backdrop of her claim that she has served continuously w.e.f.

1995 would be in the possession of the Department itself.
