Rajesh Bindal, J.

The grievance of the petitioner is that during the period 2011-12 to 2014-15 though the goods were released after provisional assessment in case of 43 bills of entry whereas four bills of entry were finally assessed and for the remaining 39 bills of entry final assessment has not yet been framed. Directions need to be given to the competent authority to decide the cases finally in all respect.

He further submitted that he is pressing the petition only pertaining to 39 bills of entry.

Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions received through e-mail submitted that final assessment pertaining to 39 bills of entry shall be made by the department after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, upto 28.02.2017.

In view of the fair stand taken by learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioner will appear before the competent authority on 22.12.2016 and the authority concerned shall finally decide all the the issues raised in pending bills of entry.
