This order shall dispose of CWP No. 13014 of 2016 (Dr. Rahul Chawla & others Vs. State of Haryana & others) and CWP No. 13161 of 2016 (Dr. Ramnika Aggarwal & others Vs. State of Haryana & others) as common issue arises in both these petitions.

Petitioners in these two connected petitions were appointed on different posts i.e. Associate Professors, Assistant Professors, Lecturers, Professors, Professors & Heads in the B.P.S Govt. Medical College for Women, Khanpur Kalan, Sonapat. Such appointments were effected in pursuance to the recommendations made by a duly constituted selection committee. Petitioner are stated to have joined on their respective posts in the years 2012/2013. Petitioners are stated to have thereafter even completed their probation period successfully.

State Govt. issued advertisement at Annexure P-3 inviting applications for filling up various posts in the faculty for Kalpana Chawla Govt. Medical College, Karnal.

Petitioners being eligible for one post or the other, have applied through proper channel and their application forms have been duly forwarded. Interview letters have been dispatched to the petitioners in relation to an interview process which is slated on 13.7.2016/15.7.2016.

The grievance of the petitioners which has led them to file these two connected petitions is that till date the requisite N.O.C and Experience Certificate has not been issued. Counsel appearing for the petitioners in these two connected petitions would submit that till date no order/communication has been served upon the petitioners even declining the issuance of N.O.C/Experience Certificate.

When these petitions came up for preliminary hearing in the pre-lunch session learned State counsel was supplied with a complete copy of the petition and was called upon to complete instructions in the matter. It is now 3.15 P.M. and the instructions are still awaited.

In the light of such situation and with the interviews slated to start on 13.7.2016 itself, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction to respondent no.3 i.e. the Director Principal, B.P.S Govt. Medical College for Women, Khanpur Kalan, District Sonapat to look into the matter as regards issuance of N.O.C and Experience Certificate to each of the petitioners. If, the petitioners are otherwise eligible the requisite N.O.C/Experience Certificate would be issued to them positively by 11.7.2016. In the eventuality of there being any impediment as regards any of the petitioners being not eligible as regards issuance of N.O.C/Experience Certificate etc., respondent no.3 would be obligated to pass a specific order in such regard and communicate the same to the petitioner concerned.

Writ petitions are disposed of, accordingly.
