S.J.VAZIFDAR, ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE (ORAL):

Mr.Doabia, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2-Bank, fairly states that the petitioner's application is pending before the higher authority for a settlement, which may include fresh schedule and repayment. In view of the nature of the matter, the Bank is also requested to look into the aspect and to see whether any reduction or waiver in respect thereof can be granted.

The petition is therefore, disposed of, without any orders at this stage, except to the extent what is stated above. The interim order dated 28.01.2015 shall continue till the decision of the higher authority on the proposal for a compromise and for a period of four weeks after the service of the decision of respondent No.2-Bank is served upon the petitioner. It is clarified that if the petitioner is

dis-satisfied with the decision, he is at liberty to challenge the same and in such a petition to raise all contentions including those contained in this writ petition.
