The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari seeking quashing of impugned action of the respondents, vide which the salary of the petitioner has been withheld upto the amount of ₹ 2,00,000/-.

On 08.08.2016, a Coordinate Bench of this Court passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to pay the entire outstanding amount due against him, but by way of installments.

Let notice of motion be issued for 25.9.2013, subject to payment of 50 % amount by the petitioner to the respondent bank within a period of three weeks.

On deposit of the 50 % amount by the petitioner, his account which is stated to be attached, shall be released till the next date of hearing.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the order dated 08.08.2013, 50 % of the amount has been deducted from the account of the petitioner. He further submits that the respondent-bank

has not filed any execution application to execute the decree and had withheld the account merely on the basis of decree passed by the civil Court.

Since the 50 % of the amount has been paid by the petitioner, so far as the remaining decreetal amount is concerned, the respondents may proceed in accordance with law for execution of the decree.

The writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
