The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to respondent No. 2 to open the financial bid of the petitioner which was furnished in pursuance to the tender issued by respondent No. 2-Municipal Committee. It was urged by learned counsel for the petitioner that there were 8 bidders for the contract in question whereas financial bids of only 3 applicants were opened without assigning any reason. It was submitted urged that no reason was assigned for not opening the bids of remaining 5 applicants. Notice of motion was issued on 08.07.2016.

2. Learned counsel for respondent No. 2 has produced a communication/decision dated 13.08.2016. A perusal of the decision of respondent No. 2 reveals that they have decided to cancel the aforesaid tender and notify fresh tender for the supply of manpower etc. The said communication of the

Municipal Committee is taken on record.

In view of the decision dated 13.08.2016 of respondent No. 2, the writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.
