Petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to set aside the movement order dated 01.07.2013.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner shall report before the JAT Regiment Centre at Bareilly within 15 days from today. Further, learned counsel has submitted that respondent No.4 be directed to consider the case of the petitioner for his discharge, sympathetically.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, in case petitioner reports before respondent No.4 within 15 days from today, then respondent No.4 shall consider his case for discharge sympathetically, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has served respondent No.4 for the last 28 years.
