Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on the directions of this Court issued vide order dated 13.2.2012 passed in CWP No.4544 of 2012, respondent No.2 passed the order dated 11.5.2012 vide which it has been admitted that petitioner had applied for the arms license on 21.10.2010, a letter for verification was sent to S.S.P. Khanna on 26.10.2010 and S.S.P. Khanna on 12.11.2011 had suggested not to issue arms license to the petitioner and on the basis of the said report, the application of the petitioner for arms license has been declined.

During the course of arguments learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to avail the remedy available to him under Section 18 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty. If the petitioner files an appeal within one month from today the same shall be heard on merits without considering the objection if any of limitation.
