This petition is filed for seeking a direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to ensure free transportation of the food grains from the mandies by the petitioner by their own trucks or by hiring the trucks from the open market without any kind of hindrance by respondents No.5 & 6. It is alleged in the petition that in the past 17 trucks of the petitioner, full of rice, were forcibly taken away by respondent No.5 but released later on, just in order to show his muscle power. Before approaching this Court, the petitioner has allegedly made a complaint to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana (Rural) seeking protection for the life and liberty of the members of the petitioner-association as well as permission to carry goods but there is no complaint made to the concerned Police Station under the relevant provisions of the IPC against the wrong doers.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition at this stage in order to make a complaint/FIR against the persons, who

have been involved previously in committing wrong to the petitioner which attract the penal provisions.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Liberty granted.

It is further ordered that in case any such application is moved to the concerned Police Station, the same shall be considered immediately, in accordance with law.
