MAHESH GROVER, J.

The prayer made in the petition is to direct the respondents No.1 and 2 not to entertain the bid of respondent No.3 if technical specifications are not met.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter which should be decided by the appropriate authorities as it is not in the domain of this Court to comment upon the issues raised in the instant petition.

Therefore, without commenting on the merits of the claims, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction to the competent authorities i.e. respondents No.1 and 2 to consider the grievance of the petitioner in accordance

with law. Ordered accordingly.

Evidently, the nature of prayer made in the petition would suggest a decision at the time of consideration of the claims.
