This order deals with CWP Nos. 13312 to 13316 of 2016 as common questions of law and facts are involved in these cases.

Notice of motion.

On our asking, Mr. Rajesh Bhardwaj, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Keeping in view the nature of order, which we propose to pass, there is no necessity to seek reply on behalf of the respondents.

The petitioner seeks quashing of the notification dated 10.04.2012, as a result of which he has been granted the benefit of notional pay fixation only without any arrears. The benefit of notional pay fixation has been granted to the petitioner in lieu of army service rendered by him during second emergency.

We find that identical controversy has been dealt with by this Court in a bunch of writ petitions including **CWP No. 17661 of 2013 [Rajinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab & Ors.]** (P-6).

We, thus, dispose of these writ petitions, without expressing any views on merits with a direction to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner and in case he is found entitled to the grant of some benefit in terms of the order [P-6], the monetary benefits, if any, shall be released to him within four months from the date a certified copy of this order is received. *Disposed of. Dasti.*
