TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

Petitioner is stated to be working as an Anganwari Worker since the year 1996. Petitioner successfully contested election of local bodies as Municipal Councilor from ward No.5, Municipal Committee, Jhajjar.

The instant petition has been filed being aggrieved of a Memo dated 01.07.2016 at Annexure P-2 issued from the office of Women and Child Welfare Project Officer, Beri in terms of which the petitioner has been called upon to submit an option to either continue as an elected representative of the M.C. or to hold the the post of Anganwari Worker.

Learned counsel during the course of arguments today would concede that the petitioner has not furnished any response to the Memo dated 01.07.2016 and neither has any final order been passed to the detriment and prejudice of the petitioner.

The present petition is, as such, disposed of being pre-mature.

Needless to observe that in the eventuality of any adverse order

being passed, it would be open for the petitioner to avail of her remedies as available strictly in accordance with law.
