Four petitioners-Shivani, Amandeep Singh, Jasbir Kaur and Satinder Kaur were engaged on contract basis as Legal Assistants, Clerks, Superintendents etc., by the Ludhiana Improvement Trust in the year 2011.

Writ petition has been filed seeking a direction to the employer for extending the tenure of the contract period, however, at the time of hearing, learned Counsel restricts his prayer for release of their consolidated salary for the period 21.12.2012 till 23.6.2013, which is the admitted period for employment (although the petitioners claimed that they have worked till 22.09.2013).

The respondent/Improvement Trust was called upon on the aforesaid limited extent.

At the time of hearing today, learned Counsel for the Ludhiana

Improvement Trust states that the required amounts in view of the aforesaid

have since been released to all four petitioners by way of separate demand drafts dated 01.08.2016. He has placed on record a letter dated 01.08.2016 in vernacular substantiating the same, which is taken on record.

Learned Counsel for the respondents thus submit that the present petition has become infructuous.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners in the light of the aforesaid stand of the respondents concedes that no further adjudication is required.

In view of the aforesaid agreed stand, the present petition stands disposed of as infructuous.
