As per office report, petitioner has been informed of the pendency of the writ petition. Despite that, there is no appearance on his behalf.

State Counsel has justified the non-payment of the additional amount of gratuity, by submitting that 5 years weightage for the handicapped employees shall be given for counting the pension only and the same shall not be admissible for the purpose of gratuity.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
