Learned counsel for the respondents produced orders relating to payment of revised pension of the petitioners.

Insofar as 5th petitioner-Pawan Kumar is concerned, there is no change. In other words, even though revised pension fixation was done but there is no change in the pension. The same is disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioners.

The present petition is disposed of reserving liberty to approach the respondents insofar as 5th petitioner-Pawan Kumar for seeking modification or change if any by producing necessary materials.

Since there is delay in settling refixation of pension and grant of monetary benefits to petitioners No.1 to 4 and the fact that respondents have earned interest on the said amount, therefore, petitioners No.1 to 4 are entitled for interest @ 6% per annum on the revised arrears of pension amount. The same shall be disbursed to petitioners No.1 to 4 within a period of three months.
