RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (Oral)

On instructions, Learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana submits that the marks for experience could not be assigned because the petitioner had not appended her M.Phil degree, while submitting her application form. Neither was the photocopy of the M.Phil certificate attached with the form nor was the original M.Phil certificate produced at the time of interview on 11.07.2014. The written instructions have been produced in Court vide memo dated 29.11.2016 addressed to Advocate General issued by the Principal of Government P.G. College, Jind, which is taken on record as Mark-A.

If the petitioner was found negligent in producing the M.Phil degree as above, than she cannot be heard to insist that she should be given weightage of 5 marks.

Learned State counsel informs the Court that petitioner is working as an Additional Lecturer in P.I.G., Government College for

Women, Jind since the academic session of 2014-15 till date.

Both the colleges adjoin each other and both are Government Colleges where she teaches and would join experience to be used whenever regular appointments as an Extension Lecturers are made.

No prejudice has been caused to the petitioner in migration from one college to the adjoining college. Therefore, I find no merit in the petition and same stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
