The petitioner seeks the relief of regularisation of his services as per terms of the policy dated 4.3.1999 (Annexure P/1) and other policies issued from time time.

It is the case of the petitioner that he is working as a part time class IV employee with respondent no.4-Market Committee, Sri Hargobindpur, District Gurdaspur since March, 1994 without any break. An advertisement had also been issued in the year 2011 for the post of Peon-cum-Chowkidar but the petitioner's case was not considered on account of being over age though he had been working with the said respondent since March, 1994.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the legal notice dated 20.10.2015 (Annexure P/3) has already been issued but no action has been taken on the same and he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent no.4 to decide the said legal notice within some fixed time frame.

Keeping in view the limited relief sought by the petitioner, this Court is of the opinion that there is no requirement of calling for any reply on behalf of the respondents.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.4 to take into consideration the said legal notice dated 20.10.2015 (Annexure P/3) and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case any adverse order is to be passed then a reasoned order be passed by the said respondent and be conveyed to the petitioner.

The present writ petition is disposed off with the aforesaid directions.
