Pleadings on record would indicate that applications were invited from amongst eligible Professors working in the Pt. B.D.Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak for the post of Floating Senior Professor.

Present petitioner being eligible applied for such post.

Grievance raised in the petition is that private respondent No.3 has wrongly claimed the benefit of 10 marks which were otherwise to be awarded by the Selection Committee only upon qualifying post-graduate degree in the first attempt whereas he has passed his post-graduate degree in the third attempt and as such he is entitled to only 06 marks as per criteria laid down. It is also the case of the petitioner that private respondent No.3 is wrongly claiming benefit of 05 marks under the head of Chapter in Foreign Book.

During the course of arguments, it has been conceded that the

process of selection is still underway and the interview is still to be held.

Under such circumstances, this Court would not be inclined to interfere in the matter merely on an apprehension that certain marks are being awarded in favour of respondent No.3 even though he is not entitled as per criteria stipulated. The selection process is still under way. The writ petition clearly as of today is premature.

Faced with such a situation, learned counsel prays for withdrawal of the present petition so as to pursue the matter with respondent authorities/competent authority in the light of representations dated 07.12.2015 (Annexure P-3) and 02.07.2016 (Annexure P-4) that are stated to have already been made.

Petition disposed of as per submission and prayer made by the counsel.
