Petitioners are serving as J.B.T Teachers under the Haryana State Education Department. Counsel refers to the tabulation furnished in paragraphs 3 and 4 of the petition to contend that employees junior to the petitioners in the J.B.T cadre are drawing higher pay and emoluments. Claim raised in the present petition as such is for grant of pay parity. It is further the contention of the counsel that the claim raised in the present petition would be covered squarely in favour of the petitioners in the light of judgement dated 15.5.2013 passed by this Court in **CWP No.11254 of 2010** titled as **Neelam Rani Vs. State of Haryana and others.**

Without making any observations on merits and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction to respondent no.2 to consider the grievance and claim of the petitioners strictly in accordance with law and to take a final decision on the legal notice dated 20.9.2015 (Annexure P-11) by passing a speaking order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
