The petitioner approached this Court for issuance of direction to the respondents for providing him medical care to get the bullets removed which are in the body of the petitioner.

This Court directed the medical re-examination of the petitioner. Accordingly, the Medical Board was constituted by the respondents, which opined that no surgical intervention was required for the foreign bodies as the same are not causing any harm to his life. The order noticing the aforesaid opinion was passed on 16.05.2012. Ever since then the case is being adjourned either on the request of learned counsel for the petitioner or in his absence.

Today, Mr. Fatehjeet Singh, Advocate, submitted that the petitioner had taken the brief from him and he has no instructions to appear.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
