The petitioner is working as Math Master after his due selection w.e.f. 07.05.1999 with the Education Department (Secondary Education), Punjab. The prayer is for directing the respondents to count the previous service rendered by him from 28.02.1989 till the date of his joining as Math Master towards qualifying service for the pension and other retiral benefits.

Upon notice, reply on behalf of the respondents/Education Department, Punjab has been filed, wherein it is stated that an order dated 18.05.2016 (**Annexure R-7**) has been passed, granting the benefit of counting of his previous service as Constable towards all pensionary benefits.

Learned State Counsel submits that in view of the stand projected in the written statement, the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as infructuous.
