The petitioner is claiming consideration for appointment on compassionate basis in terms of the policy of the Government on account of death of his father-Dharam Singh on 09.11.2010 while being employed as Head Teacher on regular basis with the Education Department (Elementary School), Government of Punjab.

It is contended that inspite of the requisite forms having been furnished for compassionate appointment on 09.03.2011 no order has been passed upon such request. It is next submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the competent authority to decide his claim as set out in the representation/writ petition in a time bound manner.

Prayer is reasonable and liable to be accepted.

Accordingly, without adverting to the merits of the case, the

writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent-competent

authority to decide his claim in accordance with law within a period of 04 months from today by passing a speaking order.
