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**RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)**

Feeling aggrieved against the official communication dated 31.08.2010 (Annexure P-2) issued by Deputy Commissioner, Faridabad to the Chief Secretary, Haryana pointing out that application of the petitioner for licence of Stamp Vendor has been filed, because at that point of time, no post of Stamp Vendor was lying vacant in the said district, petitioner has filed the present writ petition seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari.

Learned counsel for the petitioner places reliance on a list of Stamp Vendor in District Faridabad at Annexure P-12 to contend that one Kumari Shefali, whose particulars are recorded in para 11 at page 10 of the paper book, was granted licence No.149/F/2010 which would show that the post of Stamp Vendor was available and application of the petitioner was illegally rejected. He prays for setting aside the impugned order, by allowing the present writ petition.

During the course of hearing, when confronted with the fact as to how the licence of Kumari Shefali can be co-related with impugned communication (Annexure P-2) in the absence of any date of issuance of

licence in her favour, learned counsel for the petitioner had no answer and rightly so, it being a matter of record. Further, neither the order granting licence in favour of Kumari Shefali has been challenged in the present writ petition nor she is party-respondent before this Court.

In view of what has been discussed hereinabove, present writ petition is wholly misconceived, bereft of merit and without any substance, thus, it must fail. No case for interference has been made out.

Dismissed.
