RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (Oral)

Mr.Tribhuwan Dahiya states that the Government has approved the pension scheme of the University and the University in turn is prepared to grant the benefits to the petitioner as the scheme provides for deposit of the amounts of CPF to the pension fund, in case she opts for it to put the scheme in motion.

In view of this statement, it would serve the ends of justice in a more appropriate manner if a direction is issued to the University to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner with reference to

representation dated 14.12.2010 [P-5] within a month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioner is interested, she may give her option in writing to the University, the last date of which is fixed as 6.7.2016. Since the time is too short, the University would permit the petitioner to exercise her option within a fortnight from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The University may treat this petition as supplementary representation and decide the case within the time frame as above.

The petition stands disposed of with the above directions.
