The petitioner while working as Inspector Grade-II with PUNSUP was issued two charge sheets dated 28.4.2015(Annexure P-9) and 26.10.2015(Annexure P-10) for imposition of major penalty. He attained the age of superannuation at the age of 58 years on 31.7.2016. His case for grant of extension in service was not considered on the ground that there were two charge sheets pending against him, as per the policy dated 7.1.2015 (Annexure P-4). It was contended that the said two charge sheets had been stayed pursuant to the order dated 10.5.2016 passed by the M.D., PUNSUP (Annexure P-23), and were under review in the light of subsequent order dated 26.5.2016 (Annexure P-22).

Upon notice Mr.Aman Chaudhary counsel for PUNSUIP states that order dated 30.10.2014 (Annexure P-3) staying all the inquiries was subsequently annulled by the Chairman PUNSUP on 23.5.2016 and thus the basis for maintaining the present petition having been removed, the relief claimed can not be granted.

Faced with the aforesaid factual position learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition and seeks permission to withdraw this petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
