Both the petitions are disposed of with a liberty to the
petitioners to approach the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Punjab who
would go into the question of membership of the Punjab State Cooperative

Inspectors Association with reference to the decision of the Division Bench in CWP No.16919 of 2006 decided on 17.10.2008 [P-1]. In case a request is received within one month, the Registrar would examine the matter and make a final decision within 4 months after hearing the petitioners. In case the claim is justified, then payments be made accordingly. In case an adverse order is contemplated, reasons be assigned in declining the prayer with respect to the date of arrears of monetary benefits. It may be recorded that from 2005 to 2008 the arrears have been paid and the dispute revolves around ante-dated arrears from 1.1.2003.
