Counsel would submit that the petitioners were appointed as part time Sweepers in different Govt. Schools earlier in Faridabad district and at present they are serving in schools situated in Palwal district. The dates of joining of the petitioners have been furnished in para 2 of the petition i.e. between the years 1999 to 2006.

Short grievance raised is that inspite of each one of the petitioners having served as part time Sweepers for a period in excess of 10 years, yet, benefit of regularization has not been granted.

The reliance has been placed upon the policy date 18.6.2014 (Annexure P-1) issued by the State Govt. and it is contended that in terms of such policy the petitioners would be eligible to be considered for regularization.

Without making any observations on merits and without even ascertaining the correctness of averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition by granting liberty to the petitioners to file a comprehensive representation as regards their claim. In the eventuality of any such representation being preferred, respondent no.2

would be obligated to examine the same strictly in accordance with law and to take a final decision thereupon by passing a well reasoned speaking order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Petition disposed of.
