1. The sole prayer in this petition stands answered with the declaration of the result of the written test on May 29, 2013 against the advertisement dated November 23, 2012 advertising 790 vacancies of Clerks by the Central Recruitment Agency of this Court and; secondly, his marks secured in the written test held on March 24, 2013 have also been disclosed to him.

2. The short written statement filed by respondent No.2 discloses that the petitioner secured less than the minimum qualifying marks prescribed for the written examination. The petitioner was able to secure 32 out of 100 marks in the written examination (20.76 out of 50 in General Knowledge and 11.24 out of 50 in English Composition) as against the minimum 33% marks required for inclusion in the further

process of selection.

3. There is no challenge brought against the selection process in the petition. At any rate, Mr. Suresh Monga, learned counsel appearing for the High Court has drawn the attention of this Court to Annex. R-1 filed with the written statement, wherein candidates under the reserved category of Physically Handicapped persons have been selected and appointed as Clerks and posted in various Sessions Divisions three years ago.

4. There is no other prayer for this Court to answer in this petition and for the reasons recorded above, the same is found devoid of merit and stands hereby dismissed.
