consideration on the request has taken place.

Without expressing any opinion on the transfer
order or on the reasons taken against the transfer, the
competent authority in the Jail Department would hear the
petitioner on his request and take a final view of the matter.

Let the consideration take place within 7 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and status quo will maintain till then.

With the above said observations and directions, this petition is disposed of.
