This order shall dispose of CWP No.14200 of 2016 (Smt. Mukesh Goyat Vs. State of Haryana & others) and CWP No.14209 of 2016 (Sikender Singh Vs. State of Haryana & others) as identical issue is involved in both these writ petitions.

This is a matter involving transfer and posting. The issue at hand is on the point of deemed vacancy and as to whether it was correct on the part of the respondent Education Department in treating the petitioners in these two connected writ petitions to be on deemed vacancy, whereas the transfer policy dated 29.6.2016 stipulates a minimum 5 years of service in one posting so as to fall within the definition of deemed vacancy.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ravi Pratap Singh learned A.A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Complete copies of both the petitions already stand furnished to learned State counsel.

Counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that identical issue has already been dealt by a Coordinate Bench of this Court i.e. (Rajiv Narain Raina, J.) in ***CWP No.13555 of 2016 Anju Bala and others Vs. State of Haryana and others*** and other connected petitions decided on 14.7.2016.

In the light of such consensus shown by the respective counsel, these two writ petitions are also disposed of in terms of order dated 14.7.2016 passed by this Court in ***Anju Bala and others'*** case (supra).

Petitions are disposed of.
