Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned allotment dated 19.10.2012 (Annexure P-14) of L.P.G.Gas Agency to respondent No.2 under Rajiv Gandhi Gramin L.P.G. Vitrak Scheme.

Learned counsel for respondent No.1 states that no allotment has been made till date and credentials of respondent No.2 are

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being verified.
