The petitioner has approached this Court by way of filing this writ petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India, seeking a direction to official respondents No.1 to 5 to decide the application dated 14.07.2016 (Annexure P/7) moved by the petitioner stating therein that certain fake votes be deleted from the new voter list (Annexure P/5) prepared by the respondent No.4 at the behest of respondent No.7 (candidate), for the by-elections for Ward No.2 of village Madhir to be held on 24.07.2016 for the post of Panch of village Madhir. Further prayer of the petitioner is that the said elections be stayed during the pendency of the writ petition.

2. After perusal of the writ petition and hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, we do not find any ground to entertain the writ petition as it involves disputed question of facts which can be decided by the appropriate authority after examining the evidence in accordance with law.
