The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for quashing the contracts qua State Sports Complex, Sector 12, Faridabad entered with respondents No.5 to 7, which have been stated to be entered/extended without calling any tender from the open market and is also against the interest of the general public living in the Faridabad, as no other sports complex is situated in that vicinity and a huge amount is being charged by the respondents for day to day membership on account of maintenance of complex.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed and comprehensive representation to respondent No.2 raising all the pleas as have been sought to be raised in the present writ petition. However, a prayer was made that a time bound direction be issued to the concerned respondent to decide the representation expeditiously, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to file a detailed and comprehensive representation to respondent No.2 raising all the pleas as raised in the present writ petition. It is directed that in case such representation is filed by the petitioner, the same shall be decided by respondent No.2, expeditiously, by passing speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and respondents No.5 to 7, in accordance with law.
