**TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)**

Counsel would refer to the orders dated 13.03.2013 (Annexure P-10), 01.10.2014 (Annexure P-12) and dated 11.09.2015/18.09.2015 (Annexure P-14 colly.) to contend that juniors to the petitioner in the clerical cadre have been granted deemed dates of promotion on the post of Assistant. Counsel would submit that upon writ petitions having been filed in this Court, directions have been issued to the respondent Department to promote Clerks to the post of Assistant by observing that under the Rules there is no requirement to qualify the type test to be considered for promotion to the post of Assistant. As per counsel, the respondent Department has extended the benefit of the directions issued by this Court only to such employees who were writ petitioners and thereby denying identical relief to the present petitioner who otherwise is similarly situated.

Without making any observations on merit, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the claim and grievance of the petitioner and to take a final

decision on the legal notice dated 17.03.2016 (Annexure P-15) strictly in accordance with law and by passing a speaking order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
