RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.(Oral)

The petitioner claims equal treatment with Ram Kanwar, S/o Hari Chand, a part-time employee in terms of order dated July 1, 2014 regularizing his services w.e.f. January 27, 1999 instead of May 8, 2003. Similar relief is claimed as against those part-time employees who were also regularized vide order dated December 20, 2014 instead of May 8, 2003. The petitioner asserts that she is senior to those persons and her claim has been ignored for which she has served a legal notice dated October 26, 2015 (Annex P-10) on the respondents expressing her grievance. The said legal notice has not been decided as yet since nothing has been conveyed to the petitioner regarding its fate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice dated October 26, 2015 (Annex. P-10) in a time bound manner. In case the petitioner is found similarly situated as the persons mentioned in

Annex P-11 & P-12 and she is senior to them as a part time employee in Class IV post then similar treatment be accorded to her in terms of the orders relied upon. In case the petitioner is required to be heard or to produce any other documents in her support, she may be called for hearing and thereafter final order be passed within 8 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. If relief is due on principles of parity and equal treatment then there would be no necessity of passing a reasoned order and relief can flow from passing office orders.

With these observations and directions, the petition stands disposed of.
