Petitioner-Amrit Kaur is seeking the quashing of the public notice (**Annexure P-6**) whereby it is notified that a written test for recruitment to the posts of Physical Training Instructors (PTIs) would be conducted on 29.07.2016, and the candidates concerned have been directed to download their admit cards.

It is averred that the present written test is being conducted for recruitment to 646 posts of Physical Training Instructors (PTIs) advertised on 07.05.2011 (**Annexure P-2**) with the *inter alia* essential qualifications of Certificate in Physical Education (C.P.Ed.). It is claimed that the petitioner possesses the higher qualification in the same line i.e. Degree in Physical Education and, thus, being eligible is liable to be permitted to take the written test.

Upon being directed to verify the facts, learned State Counsel,

on instructions from Inderjit Singh, Deputy Director (Recruitment Board), Education Department, Punjab, submits that pursuant to the advertisement **(Annexure P-2)**, 5333 applications were received by the last date for submission of application forms i.e. 30.05.2011. That around 2304 candidates, who possessed the higher qualifications i.e. Degree in Physical Education (D.P.Ed.) instead of the advertised qualification of Certificate in Physical Education had applied and in the light of the judgment passed by this Court, are being eligible to compete for appointment to the advertised posts of Physical Training Instructors. He further submits that the petitioner did not apply pursuant to the advertisement and, therefore, now cannot make any grievance for non-joining in the selection process pursuant to the advertisement **Annexure P-2**. He further assures the Court that in future, as and when the posts of Physical Training Instructors are advertised, the persons with higher qualifications in the same line would be notified regarding their eligibility to compete.

In view of the aforesaid factual position, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
