DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

Admitted case of the parties is that the petitioners have been granted benefit of promotion in the rank of Head Constable w.e.f. 1.4.1994, however, learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have not been treated like the similarly situated persons as they have been given actual benefit, whereas, the petitioners have been given the notional benefit.

In case the petitioners have not been treated like other similarly situated persons then the petitioner is also entitled for the same benefits, which have been granted to similarly situated persons.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case the benefit granted to similarly

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situated persons has not been granted to the petitioners, the same be given to the petitioners within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of the order.

Disposed of accordingly.
