Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to issue death certificate of the son of the petitioner, namely, Gurbir Singh, being victim of Malta Boat Tragedy, who was feared to have been drowned in the Malta Sicily Channel Midway due to capsizing of the boat while immigrating to Italy on 25.12.1996.

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In pursuance of notice of motion, learned State counsel submits that necessary approval has been granted by the Director, Department of Health and Family Welfare and now death certificate is to be issued by the concerned Municipal Council after the sanction accorded by the Sub Divisional Magistrate.

In view of above, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the authorities concerned to do the needful within a period of one months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
